Testing will take place in the main auditorium. The students will write two aptitude tests and participate in a creative writing exercise. Small breaks will be provided to recharge mentally. **It is recommended that students bring a light snack and something to drink.**

S.J. Willis School is located at 923 Topaz Avenue

There is no preparation necessary for these tests and all test materials will be provided. Please bring a black or blue pen and pencil for the written portion of the test. Students are free to leave immediately after the testing session. Testing will take approximately 2 ½ - 3 hours.

Please note: S.J. Willis will not be able to provide computers for the students who have identified the need, via their I.E.P., to utilize a word processing program. Students in this situation may bring a laptop that has a USB port to transfer their written response. If a laptop is not available, accommodation will be made to have the written section completed at the student's present school or at the Challenge school of choice.
