#### Graduation Requirements

To graduate, students require 80 credits total – with a minimum of 16 at the Grade 12 level, and 28 elective course credits. 52 credits are required from the following:

- Two Career Education courses (8 credits)
- Physical & Health Education 10 (4 credits)
- Science 10 (4 credits), and a Science 11 or 12 (4 credits)
- Social Studies 10 (4 credits), and a Social Studies 11 or 12 (4 credits)
- A Math 10 (4 credits), and a Math 11 or 12 (4 credits)
- A Language Arts 10, 11 & 12 (12 credits)
- An Arts Education 10, 11, or 12 and/or an Applied Design, Skills, and Technologies 10, 11, or 12 (4 credits)

In addition, students must also complete the two new Graduation Assessments:

- Numeracy Assessment
  - Literacy Assessment
- The Literacy Assessment will be introduced in January 2020 (students graduating in the 2018/19 school year will take a Language Arts 12 course and associated provincial exam to satisfy this graduation requirement .for the 2018 Graduation Program).

NOTE: Students on the 2018 Graduation Program will be able to meet the career education graduation requirement with any of the following combinations:

- Planning 10/Grad Transitions 12
- Planning 10/Career Life Connections + Capstone
- Career Life Education/Grad Transitions 12
- Career Life Education/Career Life Connections + Capstone
