Grad Recognition Ceremony at UVIC Auditorium on Thurs, May 24th:

Ticket Purchase: All families that have not yet contacted UVIC to purchase Grad Ceremony Tickets must do so immediately to arrange for tickets. The online ticket purchase will close on April 26th at 4:00 pmlf you have not arranged for your tickets you must do so immediately. Order online, or phone the UVIC box office at phone 250-721-8480, or go to UVIC box office in person to arrange prior to April 26th.

EXTRA Ceremony Tickets: Extra Ceremony Tickets will go on sale by phone at 9:00 am sharp on Thursday, May 3rd over the phone 250-721-8480. At 9:30 am, the UVIC box opens for direct sales. If there are any tickets still available by 9:30 then you will be able to purchase in person at UVIC. I strongly suggest booking by phone as soon as the lines open. There are approximately 100 additional tickets still available for purchase. There will be a limit of two extra tickets/ student. Tickets remain \$5.00 each. To be considerate to our grad class community, PLEASE only purchase an extra ticket if you really need it.
