

GRADUATION PROGRAM

To graduate, students will require 80 credits total, with a minimum of 16 at the grade 12 level (including an English 12), and 28 elective course credits.

52 credits are required from the following:

- Two Career Education courses (8 credits): CLE and CLC
- Physical Health & Education 10 (4 credits)
- Science 10 (4 credits), and a Science 11 (4 credits)
- Social Studies 10 (4 credits), and a Social Studies 11 or 12 (4 credits)
- A Math 10 (4 credits), and a Math 11 (4 credits)
- A Language Arts 10, 11 & 12 (12 credits)
- An Arts Education 10, 11, or 12 and/or an Applied Design, Skills, and Technologies 10, 11, or 12 (4 credits)



GRADUATION PROGRAM

In addition, students may also be required to complete three Provincial Graduation Assessments in literacy and in numeracy depending on year of graduation



If I'm currently in Grade 11:

- Gr. 10 Numeracy and Gr. 10 Literacy Assessment were written in grade 10. Many of you missed it in April 2020 due to COVID - those students will be writing in April or June 2021.
- Grade 12 Literacy Assessment (2021/2022) (TBD)



Grade 12 Requirements

Students must ensure “Graduation Requirements” are met and that course selections support “after graduation” goals.
 Note: Career-Life Connections is a required course for graduation and will be added to student timetables automatically. Career-Life Connections does not count as a Grade 12 level mandatory credit or an elective choice

CHOICES TO CONSIDER...



- Basic grad = 80 credits with CLC 12 plus any four grade 12 courses including a Language Arts 12
- College Career Programs – may need specific requirements in Math and English (check with the institution to be sure)
- University transfer – English 12 with over 67%, no second language, Math 11 (check with the institution)
- University Entrance –
 - English 12 + three to five academic grade 12 courses (confirm with the institution); sometimes a 2nd language (at least to grade 11)
 - Note: some universities are looking for six to eight courses in the Grade 12 year that are specific to your area of intended study


Math Selection Process

Math is an elective in Grade 12




- See your grade 11 math teacher for guidance/advice; be honest and realistic
- Discuss your teacher's recommendation with your parents/guardians
- The general guideline is that you should have earned a C+ or higher in Pre-Calc 11 to carry on in the Pre-Calculus pathway
- An additional math pathway is Foundations 12
- Remember that many post-secondary institutions have math upgrading available
- Be sure to check post-secondary admission requirements

Honours Math



- Select math honours - if you are interested in being considered for the course
- Acceptance into math honours will be determined by the math department based on the application process and teacher recommendation
- Just because you are in math honours this year, does NOT guarantee you'll be in math honours next year
- A math honours class will run only if there is enough interest


General Guidelines




- Any unsuccessful courses from grade 11 should be discussed with a counsellor (you may have some options)
