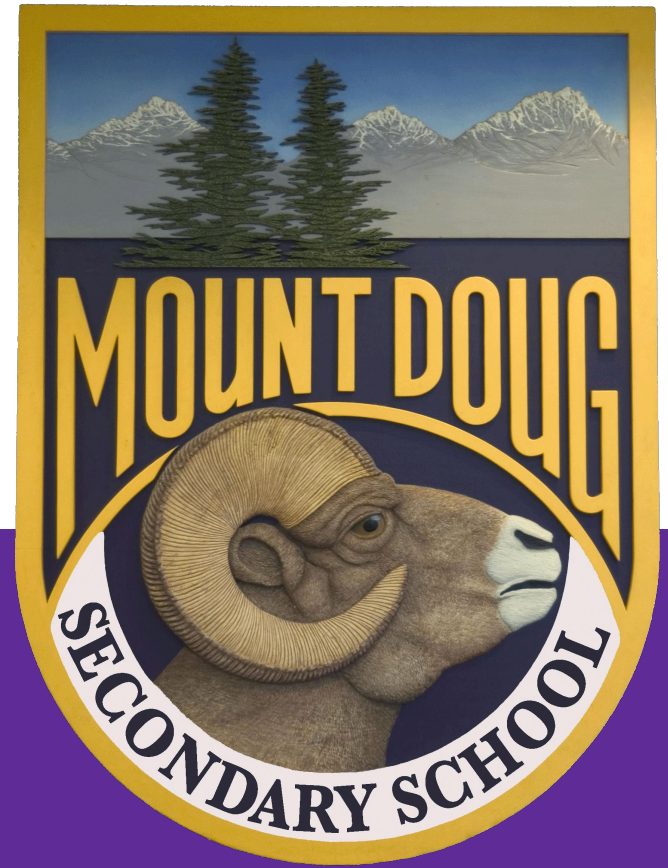

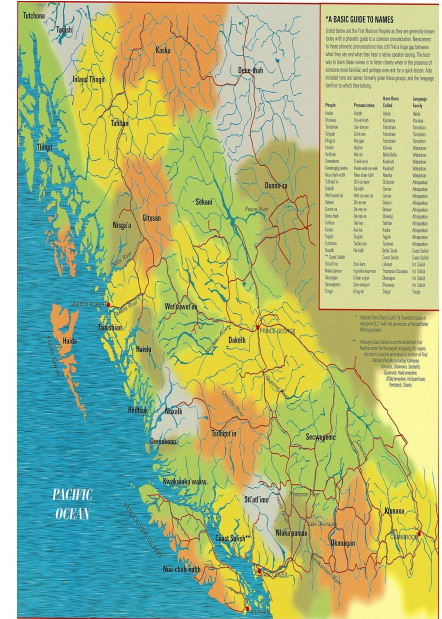

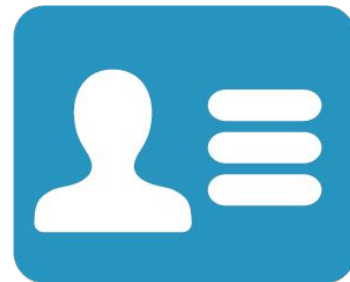

GRADUATION PROGRAM

To graduate, students will require 80 credits total, with a minimum of 16 at the grade 12 level (including English 12 and CLC)

Other required courses:

-

 - Physical Health & Education 10 (4 credits)
 - Science 10 (4 credits), and a Science 11 (4 credits)
 - Social Studies 10 (4 credits), and a Social Studies 11 or 12 (4 credits)
 - A Math 10 (4 credits), and a Math 11 (4 credits)
 - A Language Arts 10, 11 & 12 (12 credits)
 - An Arts Education 10, 11, or 12 and/or an Applied Design, Skills, and Technologies 10, 11, or 12 (4 credits)
 - An Indigenous focused graduation course (either a Language Art 10 or 12, or a Socials 12)

- requires strong literacy skills whether students aspire to pursue a university degree or college program, or to proceed directly into the workplace

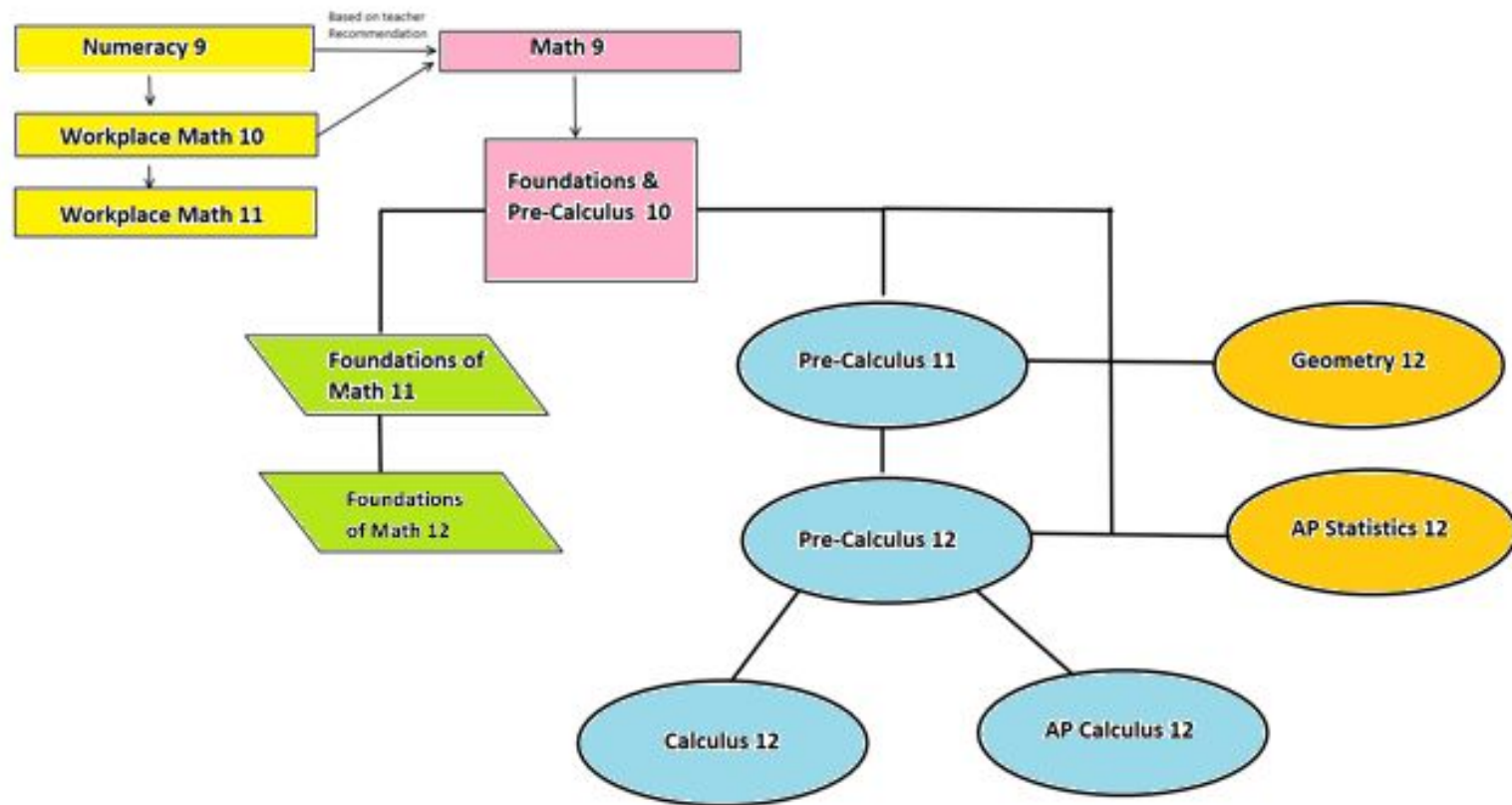

- See your grade 10 math teacher for guidance/advice.
- Discuss your teacher's recommendation with your parents.
- The general guideline is that you should have earned a C+ or higher in Foundations and Pre-Calculus 10 to carry on in the Pre-Calculus pathway.
- Additional Math pathways are Foundations of Math 11 and Workplace Math 11.
- Remember that many post-secondary institutions have math upgrading available.
- Be sure to check post-secondary admission requirements.
- Be honest and realistic.

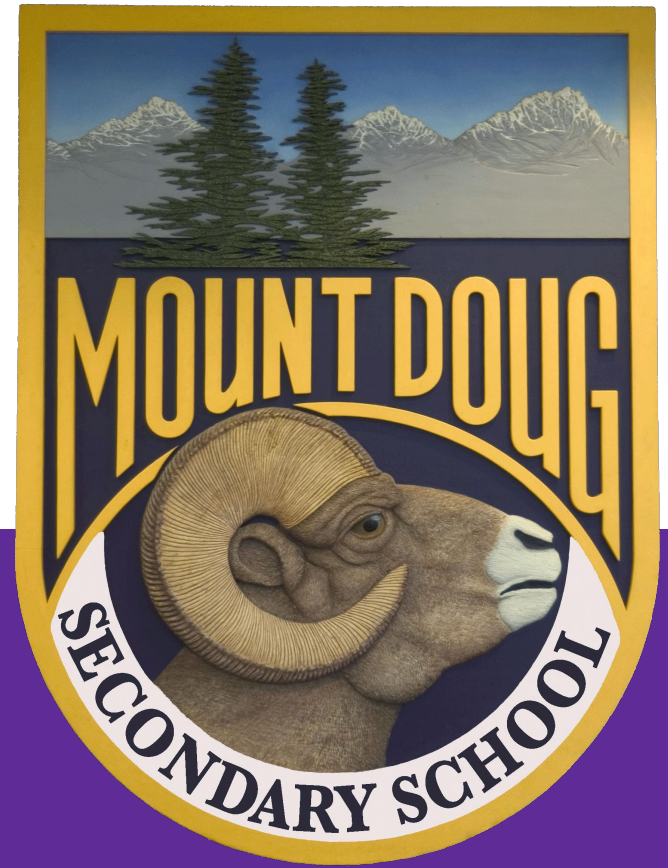
General Guidelines



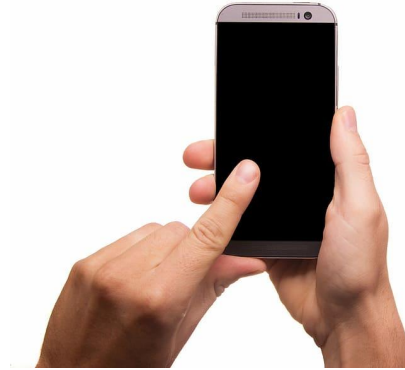
- Any unsuccessful courses from grade 10 should be discussed with a counsellor (you may have some options)
