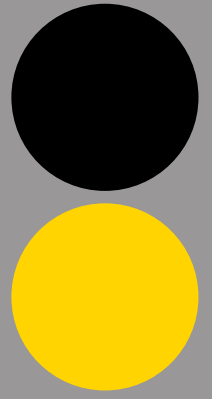


GRADE 10



Course Requirements Overview

Grade 10 is the first year of the graduation program. Students will earn credits towards graduation and will receive percentages rather than proficiency scales. For information on what is required for graduation, students can look [here](#). There are 5 required courses for grade 10 students and 3 elective choices. Grade 10 students must also write the Literacy 10 assessment during their grade 10 year. They will write Numeracy 10 in their grade 11 year, and Literacy 12 in their grade 12 year.

Required courses:

- an English 10
- Science 10
- Socials 10
- a Math 10 (FMPC 10 OR Workplace 10)
- PE 10

All students graduating must successfully complete at least one 4-credit course in Indigenous-focused coursework. Students may choose to meet this requirement through English First People 10 courses, or through a grade 12 Socials or English course. When choosing their math course, students should consider the recommendation made by their teacher on their learning update or consult with their current math teacher.

Students may want to explore different elective opportunities in their grade 10 year than they did in their grade 9 year.
