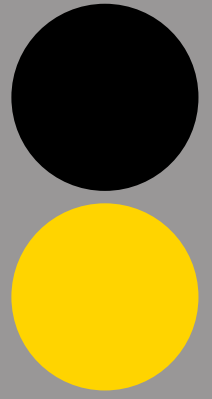


GRADE 12



Course Requirements Overview

Grade 12 is the final year of secondary school. For information on what courses are specifically required for graduation, students can look [here](#) or access their Diploma Verification Reports through the MyEd portal. Grade 12 students must ensure they have written the Numeracy 10 and Literacy 10 assessments and expect to write the final Literacy 12 assessment during this year.

Required courses for graduation:

- an English 12 (*English First Peoples 12 or English Studies 12*)
- Career Life Connections 12 (done outside the timetable)

All students graduating must successfully complete at least one 4-credit course in Indigenous-focused coursework prior to graduation. Students may have met this requirement through English First People 10 courses, or could plan to take either a Contemporary Indigenous Studies or English First Peoples.

Students need also to consider the courses required for access to the post-secondary institution of their choosing.
